January's Meeting

Jay Marino's Program was very good, a lot of useful information was shared. Jay taught us how to "shoot" our projects as if they were products to be sold. He said to use a 30° angle for the light source and the camera angle. Never shoot from straight on. Create contrast and shadow and have the main feature of the project to the left in the picture. We practiced taking pictures with various settings and lighting. Jay said to use the "P" or Program setting on the camera, not "A" for Auto (or Average). That just levels out everything in the picture.
